LOCKDOWN LEVEL 2

 <p>Wear a mask at all times when closer than 3m from another person.</p>	 <p>Daily screening on arrival at work.</p>	 <p>Sanitize hands regularly.</p>	 <p>Caddies to be allocated their OWN locker or allocated a specific area for personal items.</p>	 <p>Maintain 3m distance at all times.</p>	 <p>Avoid touching the player's golf clubs, balls, tees, towel or personal items.</p>	 <p>BOTH the player and caddie must wash/sanitize their hands regularly during the round.</p>	 <p>Sanitize the golf bag BEFORE and AFTER the round (especially the strap and handles).</p>
 <p>No shaking of hands.</p>	 <p>Do not touch the scorecard.</p>	 <p>No rakes in bunkers.</p>	 <p>If you are assigned to maintain a bunker, only you may use the rake.</p>	 <p>Do not touch the flagstick.</p>	 <p>Do not touch or pick up golf balls.</p>	 <p>Payment of caddies: Sanitize the cash.</p>
